ACT How to Write a Thank You Note

- 1. When a thank you note is handwritten it seems more thoughtful, but because we are doing most things virtually right now, an email is okay.
- 2. Your note should have five parts:
 - a. Greeting- An expression of hello to whom you are writing
 - b. Reason- Why you are writing your thanks
 - c. Wish- Something nice you want for these essential workers
 - d. Compliment- Something you admire about these essential workers
 - e. Closing- A kind word to say goodbye followed by your first name and age
