Brooks writes impeccably researched historical novels and won the Pulitzer Prize in 2006 for *March* and her international bestsellers include *Caleb's Crossing*, *People of the Book* and *Year of Wonders*. Her latest book, *Horse*, is based on the true story of a record-breaking racehorse which blends narratives from 1850 Kentucky, 1994 New York City, and 2019 Washington, DC into a sweeping novel

about science, art, obsession, and injustice in America. A former *Wall Street Journal* correspondent for Bosnia, Somalia, and the Middle East, Brooks delves deeply into history with a journalist's eye for detail and a master storyteller's sense of character. She has also written the acclaimed nonfiction works *Nine Parts of Desire* and *Foreign Correspondence*. Born and raised in Australia, she now lives in Massachusetts.
