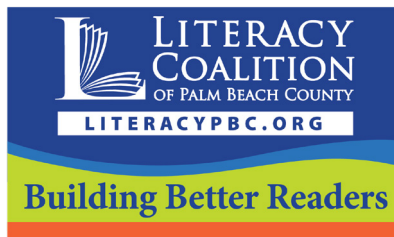


BE A VOLUNTEER TUTOR
